



## **Admissions FAQs:**

### **Is there a fee waiver?**

### **Are we accepting international students?**

We admit international students every year and plan to continue to do so this year.

### **Are there post-bac opportunities?**

### **What does the admissions committee consider most important when reviewing applications?**

While our admissions committee takes a holistic approach to reviewing applications, admitted applicants will have substantial practical research experience, strong letters of recommendation that speak to the individual's ability to complete a study, and academic distinction.

### **Do I need to get a faculty member's endorsement before applying?**

The short answer is no. Admissions decisions are made by a committee, and individual faculty members cannot admit, accept, or agree to work with (or decline to admit, accept, or work with) individual applicants. You are still welcome to reach out to faculty members with whom you hope to work, but these communications will not influence whether you're admitted.

### **Is there specific coursework I should take before applying?**

As an interdisciplinary program with students from diverse academic backgrounds, we do not have a list of required courses or majors.
