The Department of Pathology will provide a travel grant for two Pathology and Molecular Medicine students bi-annually in the amount of \$1000.00 to support travel to a recognized professional domestic or international conference and academic meetings. Students must be Pathology and Molecular Medicine students in good standing to be eligible for funding for one conference per fiscal year (July 1-June 30)

Application due date: January 1, 2026, and July 1, 2026

Students should apply at least 30 days before the start of the conference. A student may only have one application pending at any time.

Selection Process:

Travel Award Committee consists of faculty and Graduate Students. The committee will review all the applications and notify the applicants of the decision.
